Fee Explanation for Age Group Swimmers:

YMCA Program Dues: (425) This money goes directly to the Riverfront YMCA to pay for many aspects of our program including pool rental, coach's salaries for practice time, team insurance etc...

YMCA Membership Dues & Start-up fee: It is a requirement for all YMCA swim team members to be members of their YMCA. These fees go directly to the YMCA to cover membership costs.

Booster Fee: This is a \$75 per family fee. This fee covers your Tigershark Booster Club membership. The boosters use this money along with money raised through fundraising to provide members the items from the below list plus much more.

Escrow Fee: This is an account set up for each family to be used to pay for your entry fees into invitational meets. Money can be added to this account at any time by getting a check made out to CFYN to our treasurer. An initial deposit of \$60 is recommended but not required. You will be responsible for any invitational fees you incur.

USA Membership: All swimmers have the option to join USA swimming. This is a national fee that all USA swimmers must pay.
