** Subsidy applies ONLY to swimmers whose immediate family had a Tigershark registered in the 2025/26 Short Course season and the family is in good standing with the team, meaning they participated in the fundraising efforts, and completed their volunteer obligations. Escrow accounts must be paid in full in order to register for the new season.*

The Tigershark Long Course swim team is owned and operated by the Tigershark Booster Club. The Tigersharks reserve the right to limit team size or refuse registrations for any reason. We also reserve the right to terminate membership if necessary at any time during the season should our policies and code of conduct be violated. No refund will be given if a swimmer is removed from the team for this type of violation.

USA Memberships are required for ALL Long Course swimmers. Registration is done online. Directions on how to register will be sent when we receive your registration form. You will not be able to begin practicing until you are registered. If you registered as a USA swimmer during the 2026 short course season, you do not need to register again for a long course USA registration. YMCA membership is NOT required for this program.

USA Membership	Cost	Description
<i>Premium Membership</i>	\$82 (paid to USA Swimming)	Membership through December 31, 2026.
<i>Seasonal Membership</i>	\$47 (Paid to USA swimming)	Entitles swimmers to 150 days of membership.
<i>CFYN USA Fee</i>	\$20 (paid to CFYN)	This fee is paid once per calendar year to help offset the administrative costs of running the USA program.

Be sure to check the website to register for meets.** Relays will be made for meets based on swimmers in attendance. If you swimmer is selected for a relay and they don't swim, due to you not attending or leaving the meet, you may be charged for the cost of the relay.

Escrow Acknowledgment Form

What are escrow accounts

An escrow account is money that the team holds on your behalf to pay for expenses that you incur related to invitational meets. All long course invitationals have entry fees. Most meets cost \$5-\$8 per swim, plus a \$4 Ohio Swimming surcharge, and many meets charge an upfront facility fee, usually around \$12. We draw funds from your escrow account to pay these fees.

What happens to my positive escrow balance at the end of the year

At the conclusion of the current season, you have several options of things to do with your positive escrow balance.

1. You may carry the balance over to the next season (this is the most common).
2. You may donate the balance to the team.
3. You may donate the balance to another swimmer/family.
4. **You may request a check from the treasurer for your positive escrow balance.**

What happens if my escrow account is negative

It is common for an escrow account to be negative at some point in the season. This can be due to several factors including the timing of when the treasurer enters the credits and debits in the system. If your escrow account is negative, don't panic, you can make a payment by contacting the treasurer and requesting an on-line invoice (service charges apply) or give her a check, made out to CFYN Tigersharks, for the amount you would like added to your escrow. If your account is negative for an excessive time, or for a large amount, we may require a deposit prior to entering additional meets. If you have a negative escrow balance at the end of the season, we require you to pay it in full before you can register for the next season.

What happens if I leave the team

If you leave the team and have a positive escrow balance you can contact the treasurer at treasurer@cfyntigersharks.com to inform them of what you would like done with your balance. If you do not register with the team for two (2) consecutive (calendar) years all positive escrow balances will become donations to the team.

Do I have to put money in my escrow account?

You must have an active escrow account with a positive balance in order for us to begin entering your swimmer in meets. We recommend a minimum deposit to at least cover your first meet.
